- 3. The water samples are eligible for import under Part 2.1 of the above import health standard; and must be directed to the containment facility listed on this permit.
- 4. The primary packaging of the water samples must only be opened within the containment facility listed on this permit.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PERMIT HOLDERS AND AGENTS

- This permit, and compliance with the provisions of the specific import health standard(s) and/or entry conditions, does not guarantee that the goods you import will be given biosecurity clearance. IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PERMIT HOLDERS AND AGENTS

 - clearly labelled with the scientific strain and name
 - consigned in leakproof packaging
 - free from contaminants
- All new organisms must not be opened until received by the nominated containment facility.
