- 2. Consignments must also be imported in accordance with the HSNO Act approvals NOC100151 and NOC100152, which are available at the following website: https://www.epa.govt.nz/database-search/hsno-application-register/view/APP201737
- 3. The water samples are eligible for import under Part 2.1 of the above import health standard; and must be directed to the containment facility listed on this permit.
- 4. The primary packaging of the water samples must only be opened within the containment facility listed on this permit.
- 5. All documentation must be attached to the package in such a way that the primary packaging does not need to be opened for access to the documents.

This permit, and compliance with the provisions of the specific import health standard(s) and/or entry conditions, does not guarantee that the goods you import will be given biosecurity clearance. - 5 Unless specifically identified in 'Description of Items' or 'Special Conditions' of the permit, NO new organisms, including genetically modified organisms, are permitted entry under this permit.
- 6 All cultures must be
 - clearly labelled with the scientific strain and name
 - consigned in leakproof packaging
 - free from contaminants
- 7 All new organisms must not be opened until received by the nominated containment facility.
